Cascade Lakes Brewing Co.

Bend, OR

30 IBU, 5.2%

This proprietary craft ale is made locally with finest malts, hops and barley anywhere. Brewed in the Northwest style, this is a well-balanced, medium bodied ale, with a malty aroma, crisp, clean finish, and a pure golden color.

Knotty Blonde

RPM IPA

75 IBU, 7.5%

The new guys on the block at Boneyard bring us this fantastic single IPA. Pineapple and Citrus notes, clear, copper color with a moderate head, this IPA packs a huge hop punch. Boiled and dry hopped using four Northwest hop varieties

Apocalypse IPA

10 Barrel Brewing Co.

Bend, OR

65 IBU, 6.5%

A Northwest American-Style IPA. Fruity and citrusy hop aroma shines, with hints of pine resin. The malt character is clean and smooth with a unique toasted flavor (thanks to the generous helping of Victory malt), all held together by a firm bitterness. Apocalypse has a medium-bodied mouth feel, finishing crisp and dry.

Believer Double Red Ale
