Central Oregon’s recent growth has also enhanced its access into and out of Roberts Field Airport (RDM) in Redmond, 35 miles north of Sunriver. In addition to the daily flights servicing the cities of Portland, Seattle, San Francisco, and Salt Lake City, direct routes to Las Vegas and Denver have been added. United Express, Horizon, SkyWest, and Allegiant airlines now service Roberts Field. For guest convenience, Sunriver Resort offers complementary shuttle services to and from the airport, and also provides a private airstrip for general aviation. For leisure travelers looking for the ultimate scenic drive, traveling to Sunriver is more convenient thanks to a \$10 million project by the Oregon Department of Transportation. The entrance to the resort and community is highlighted by a new interchange with four ramps allowing access to and from the resort in either direction
