- ACCESSIBILITY:** Roberts Field (RDM) in Redmond, located 35 miles south of Sunriver, has direct flights throughout the day to and from Portland, Seattle, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Las Vegas, and Salt Lake City via United Express, Horizon Air (Alaska) and SkyWest Airlines (Delta).
- Sunriver Resort also boasts its own airstrip, less than one mile from the Lodge, where corporate and private aircraft can fly guests directly to the property.
- LODGING:** Resort accommodations include nearly 250 Lodge Village guest rooms and suites complete with wood-burning fireplaces and private decks and more than 400 private homes and condominiums, ideal for families and larger parties.
- River Lodges (33 total) are elegant and spacious rooms along the Sun River between the Sunriver Lodge and the Great Hall Conference Center.

**SUNRIVER LODGE:**

The focal point of the resort is Sunriver Lodge, which captures the history of the area while highlighting the grandeur of the Great Northwest. This elegant showpiece provides a place to relax and enjoy the magnificent views and offers several dining options, entertainment, a specialty shopping experience and art gallery. Concierge services, the award winning Meadows Golf Shop, meeting / banquet rooms, and guest registration are also located in the Sunriver Lodge.

***The Grille at Crosswater***

Amidst a memorable setting reflective of the region, The Grille at Crosswater boasts a diverse menu featuring fresh, innovative Northwest cuisine for both lunch and dinner. An impressive selection of entrees — featuring steaks, fresh seafood, pastas, and daily specials — is complemented by an array of tantalizing soups, salads and appetizers. Located in the Merchant Trader on the lower level of the Sunriver Lodge. Relax with coffee and breakfast or a noontime sandwich or salad as you browse through our fabulous and unique merchandise. Summer outdoor seating available. During the summer (mid-June through August), dinner is available from 5 to 9 p.m. with live acoustic music Friday and Saturday nights.

## **RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES:**

A recreational paradise, Sunriver Resort boasts 63 holes of championship golf; 28 tennis courts; 35 miles of paved bike paths; three swimming complexes; horseback riding; a marina with kayak and canoe rentals and fly fishing. Sunriver Resort is truly a four-season destination and is only 18 miles northwest of world-class downhill skiing, snowboarding and cross-country skiing at Mt. Bachelor. Additionally, off-site activities include mountain bike tours, rock climbing, ATV rentals, nature tours and whitewater rafting.

## **SPA:**

## **CONFERENCE AND BANQUETS:**

With more than 44,000 square feet of flexible meeting and banquet space, breakout sessions, meals and exhibits are all in close proximity. Here's a closer look at Sunriver's exceptional meeting facilities:

**Homestead**—The Resort's largest meeting and banquet space can accommodate up to 650 guests or up to 540 guests at a sit-down function. The main room can be divided into three smaller rooms and is ideal for groups of all sizes. The outdoor lawn area boasts views of the Meadows Golf Course and Sun River, and can host up to 350 guests.

**Great Hall Conference Center**—With variety of rooms, from the historic Great Hall itself with its exposed beams and magnificent fireplace to the intimate Fireside Room, the conference center is ideal for executive board meetings. For smaller gatherings or additional breakout space, the Heritage and Landmark rooms offer great flexibility. All rooms within the Great Hall Conference Center offer windows and outdoor deck usage.

**Sunriver Lodge**—With up to 3,400 square feet of meeting space, the Lodge offers space for as many as 250 guests. The luxurious River Lodges have three beautifully appointed galleries perfect for board meetings or a reception. The Vandevent and Fremont rooms, located in the Sunriver Lodge, have been transformed into residential-style dens, perfect for smaller executive board meetings and private dining gatherings (or, even, a video game room). Both dens feature comfortable Northwest furnishings; two Dell computers with high-speed Internet access connected to 20-inch flat panel screens; 42-inch HDTV; DVD player; and full WIFI coverage.

**RESORT HISTORY:**

More than 60 years ago, Sunriver Resort was the home of Camp Abbot, which held major training exercises for the Army Corps of Engineers during World War II. The camp's proximity to the nearby Deschutes River provided rich training opportunities including learning how to build bridges over rivers, a skill that was essential during WWII. Construction on Camp Abbot's Officer's Club—Sunriver Resort's Great Hall—began in October 1943 and was completed six months later.
